ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Captain Bryon K. Fryer distinguished himself by meritorious service as Cyberspace Operations Development Engineer, Information Exploitation and Operations Division, Information Directorate, Detachment 10, Air Force Research Laboratory, Air Force Materiel Command, Rome Research Site, New York. During this period, Captain Fryer led a joint collaborative effort, merging research and development for the United States intelligence community. He penned a unique flexible cyber domain concept, saving the Air Force 100,000 dollars and decreasing integration timeframes by 40 percent. Additionally, Captain Fryer directed 10 million dollars in state-of-the-art cyber research and development programs, transitioning eight programs to the National Security Agency, increasing the agency's situational awareness by 300 percent and decreasing developmental testing by 25 percent. Furthermore, while serving as the unit deployment manager he facilitated six deployments, ensured the combat readiness of 58 active duty members, and directed a records review resulting in zero discrepancies. Finally, he developed a future cyber acquisition strategy and wrote a 50 million dollar contracting vehicle for refining program requirements, cutting the length of the cyber research and development lifecycle process by 50 percent. The distinctive accomplishments of Captain Fryer while serving his country reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
